Al-Anon and Alateen are spiritual programs of recovery which are compatible with all religious beliefs and practices. The Al-Anon/Alateen program can aid the recovery process for the entire family through hope, comfort and loving interchange among members having a common problem. When someone turns to you for help and an alcohol/drug related problem is identified, we urge you to suggest that they attend Al-Anon and/or Alateen meetings. Al-Anon Family Groups can help you help those who are struggling with the effects of this disease.
