Head coach Anne Wilkinson is in her 17th season at the helm of Ohio State and in her 26th season overall as a head coach. She has coached over 400 games and earned the 2006 Big Ten Coach of the Year award. She was named NFHCA West Region Coach of the Year in 2006 and 2010. In 2011 she helped the Buckeyes to their 3rd consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time an OSU squad had done so. In 2012 she claimed her 200th victory at Ohio State becoming the first coach in program history to do so.

Under Wilkinson's guidance, the Buckeyes have garnered numerous awards in the classroom as well. In 16 years they have earned 67 NFHCA National Academic Squad Awards, 87 Academic All-Big Ten Selections, 136 OSU Scholar-Athlete accolades and three Big Ten Medal of Honor recipients.

Anne's international field hockey experience included playing with the U.S. Under 21 National Team and the Under 23 National Team. She was a four year participant in the U.S. Olympic Festival, capturing a Gold Medal in 1985. In 1998 she was an assistant coach for the U.S. Under 23 National Team.

At the development level, Wilkinson is the Director of the prestigious All-American Field Hockey Camps, Inc. which are now held at Ohio State University. She is also an active member of the National Field Hockey Coaches Association.
