Diabetic Supplies covered through the Durable Medical Equipment (DME) & Supplies benefit through the IBC Medical Plan

- Blood Glucose Monitors
- Interstitial Continuous Glucose Monitoring Systems
- Insulin Pumps and Associated Supplies
- Injection Aides
- Alcohol Swabs
- Lancing Devices
- Blood and Urine Test Strips
- Insulin Pens, Needles, and Syringes for the administration of injectable diabetic medications
- Glucagon Emergency Kits

Please note: The DME benefit through IBC allows you to purchase diabetic supplies as long as you have a prescription from your doctor and use an IBC participating DME provider.
