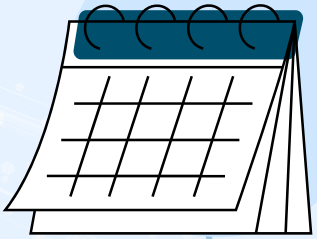


FLEXIBLE INSTRUCTION DAY (FID) QUICK GUIDE

OVERVIEW



WCASD has five approved FIDs that count as school days, meaning they are not required to be made up at a later date. Zoom check-ins will take place and learning assignments are provided for students to complete at home.

COMMUNICATION



The WCASD superintendent will inform families and staff of an FID. Teachers and staff will communicate with students throughout the day via Zoom, email, Seesaw, and/or Schoology.

ATTENDANCE



Elementary students log into their learning platform by 9:00 a.m. and secondary students login to Zoom and respond to Schoology prompts each class period starting at 9:00 a.m. Any assigned work must be completed as well.

PARTICIPATION ISSUES



Families experiencing problems with internet connectivity or other challenges for attending FID, should email or submit a note to the school when the student returns for the absence to be excused.
