B5	Time	Students will: Look at digital and analog clocks and state the time to the hour and half hour. Know the following time words: morning, night, afternoon, and o'clock

B6	Money	Students will know: The names of U.S. coins and the dollar bill The value of U.S. coins and bills
B7	Following School Directions:	Students will follow basic commands: Stand up / sit down Open / close Color / draw Raise your hand Repeat / say Turn to page ____ Match Find Write / print / copy Take out your books Read Listen Fill-in Touch your _____
B8	Classroom Objects	Students will identify: Basic classroom objects (eg. Pencil, backpack, paper, desk)

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C1	School Personnel & Facilities	Students will Identify:
		School personnel by name and title (eg. principal, nurse, teachers, custodians)
		School facilities (eg. cafeteria, bathroom, office)
C2	Family	Students will identify:
		Family members and relationships (eg. Mother, father, grandmother, grandfather, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, cousin)
C3	Feelings	Students will:
		Recognize and identify feelings (happy, sad, angry, tired, scared)
C4	Body Parts	Students will identify:
		Names of basic body parts (eg. Hand, foot, head)
C5	Clothing	Students will:
		Identify items of clothing (eg. Shirt, pants, shoes)
		Match clothing to appropriate seasons of the year.
C6	Senses	Students will:
		Identify the five senses
C7	House & Home	Students will identify:
		Rooms in a house
		Types of housing (eg. house, apartment, trailer)
		Basic items in a home (eg. Bed, stove, bathtub)

		Identify names of meals
		Identify categories of foods (eg. vegetables, fruits, meats)
		Express likes and dislikes
C9	Interests	Students will:
		Express interests using like and don't like
C10	Community	Students will identify:
		Community helpers (eg. teacher, mail carrier, police officer)
		Important places in the community (eg. school, post office, police station)
C11	Math	Students will identify U.S. customary units of measure
		Identify terminology and symbols of basic math operations (eg. +, add, plus, -, subtract, minus, x, multiply, times, ÷, divide, divided by)
C12	Animals	Students will:
		Identify common animals
C13	Geography	Students will:
		Understand concepts of city, state, country, continent, world, town, suburb, city (urban), country (rural), ocean
		Locate places on a map
		Know directional words (N,S,E,W)
