





Tobacco and Vaping Past 30 days








Type of Vaping















Sources of prescription drugs by students who reported prescription drug use West Chester Area School District 2019 Pennsylvania Youth Survey







Gambling West Chester Area School District 2019 Pennsylvania Youth Survey











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



Perceived reasons for bullying









Perception of risk






