The Report for the Proposed 2011-12 Transportation Plan Changes is Available for Public Review

A report has been completed by the Transportation Task Force Committee and is now available to the public for review. The report covers the 2011-12 proposed transportation changes and is being shared with members of the School Board prior to Property and Finance Committee consideration of the proposal, as well as a vote on adoption by the full Board should the P&F Committee move the plan forward.

In addition to the complete transportation report, members of the School Board also receive, in a secure method, all feedback provided to the District from parents of public school and non-public school families over the course of the last few months. Parent feedback came in the form of comment cards which were filled out at one of the three parent meetings, and through e-mail sent to the District raising parental concerns, comments, and questions.

Some parents have expressed concern that the School Board will adopt the transportation plan proposal before a specific bus stop concern can be addressed. The process to be put in place will allow for a review of any parent concern or question and will begin only after the Board takes action to move forward with the plan. Concerns would be reviewed by the Transportation Department during the remainder of this school year, as well as over the course of the summer if necessary. No parent will face the start of the 2011-12 school year without having a safety concern or other question addressed.
